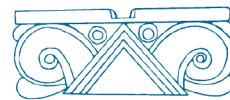

Call for proposal – 2021

The Roger and Susan Hertog Center has made M.A., Ph.D. and Post Doc scholarships available for excellent students who will pursue in the Institute of Archaeology at the Hebrew University of Jerusalem, cutting-edge research on a range of topics related to the archaeology of Jerusalem and Judah throughout the ages.

The M.A. scholarship recipient will be awarded \$20,000 per year for two years (October 2020–September 2022).
The Ph.D. scholarship recipient will be awarded \$27,000 per year for four years (October 2020–September 2024).
The Postdoctoral scholarship recipient will be awarded \$40,500 per year for one year (October 2020–September 2021) and is open to scholars who have received or have approval of their Ph.D. within the last three years before the scholarship commences.

For M.A. scholarships please provide a letter of application, curriculum vitae, B.A. transcripts (and 1st year M.A. if relevant), short description of the intended subject of research (1 page), one letter of recommendation, one letter from a potential supervisor (member of the teaching staff at the Institute), declaration of additional funding received for the M.A.

For Ph.D scholarships please provide a letter of application, curriculum vitae and List of Publications, M.A. transcripts, a short description on the intended subject of research (2 pages), two letter of recommendations, one letter from a potential supervisor (member of the teaching staff at the Institute), declaration of additional funding received for the Ph.D

For Postdoctoral scholarships please provide a letter of application, curriculum vitae and List of Publications, a short description of the Ph.D thesis (up to 5 pages), a short description of the intended subject of research and work plan (2 pages), two letters of recommendations, a letter of invitation from a staff member at the Institute, declaration of additional funding received for the post-Doc.
